

PulTab Reference Guide

How to play, how to run a pool, and what the buttons do.

The basics

- Each game has one card per period (quarters for football, halves for basketball).
- A card holds 10 tabs numbered 0-9. Every tab hides one digit.
- The winning tab for a period is the one whose hidden digit matches the last digit of the two teams' combined score.
- **Final score = end of regulation. Overtime does NOT count.**

Playing

- Sign in, open Games, and pick the game you want.
- Click any open tab to claim it. Your name appears on the tab.
- Click the X on your own tab to give it back, as long as it is not marked paid yet.
- My Tickets lists everything you hold plus your hidden digits once revealed.
- Pay your organizer directly; they mark your tabs paid.

When a card fills up

- When all 10 tabs are claimed the organizer is alerted and can open a fresh card for that period.
- Players get a bell notification whenever a new card opens.
- Once a score is posted for a period, no new cards can be opened for it.

Joining a pool

- Your organizer sends a friendly join code such as LUCKY-TIGER-42, or a direct join link.
- Use Join in the header, paste the code, and you are in as a player.
- Players who join with a code see only the player view - no organizer tools.

For organizers

- Admin lists your games sorted by start time. New Game builds the cards and all 0-9 tabs.
- Enter scores per period, apply a score to every card of that period, or clear it to start over.
- Player Balances shows what each player owes. 'All paid' marks a whole card paid at once.
- SMS Invites texts your join code to many numbers at once. Email Players gives every address to copy or open in Gmail.
- New organizers get a 14-day trial; afterwards games stay viewable but new ones need full access.

Fair play & privacy

- PulTab is for entertainment among friends only. It is not a real-money gambling service.
- Hidden digits are stored separately and are never visible in the browser before they are revealed.

Questions? Ask your pool organizer - they can adjust scores, payments and cards.
